STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for the Construction of a
Sewer Main for the Bangor State Hospital.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of three thousand dollars to be expended by the City
3 of Bangor under the direction of the trustees of the Bangor
4 State Hospital, in altering, relocating and constructing an
5 adequate sewer or sewage system from the Bangor State
6 Hospital to the Penobscot river, said sewer or sewage sys-
7 tem to be so located and constructed as to safeguard the
8 water supply and health of the city of Bangor, provided
9 that the city of Bangor shall raise and expend in addition
10 to the sum above mentioned, whatever sum of money may
11 be necessary to make said sewer adequate for the purposes
12 aforesaid.
