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**STATE OF MAINE**

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

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AN ACT Relating to Intoxicating Liquors.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section fifty-five of chapter two hundred and nine of the  
2 public laws of nineteen hundred and seventeen, is hereby  
3 amended by adding after the words "business of said com-  
4 pany or individual" at the end of said section, the words  
5 'but the provisions of this section shall not apply to sacra-  
6 mental wines to be used for sacramental purposes,' so that  
7 said section as amended shall read as follows:

'It shall be unlawful for any transportation company, ex-  
2 press company, corporation, or individual to deliver any  
3 intoxicating liquors at any place other than the regular place  
4 of business of same company or individual, but the pro-  
5 visions of this section shall not apply to sacramental wines  
6 to be used for sacramental purposes.'
