STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Create a State Broadcasting Station.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The governor and council are hereby authorized and directed to investigate the need, location, cost of construction, expense of maintenance and desirability of the establishment of a state radio broadcasting station; with full power to act in any manner which in their judgment may be for the best interests of the state.
