STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, for Charitable, and Benevolent Institutions, for the Care, Support and Medical or Surgical Treatment of Certain Persons.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for 2 the fiscal year from July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-3 five to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-six, the 4 sum of one hundred and ninety-seven thousand nine hun-5 dred and fifty dollars and for the fiscal year from July 6 first, nineteen hundred and twenty-six to June thirtieth, 7 nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, the sum of one hundred 8 and ninety-seven thousand nine hundred and fifty dollars, 9 for the necessary care and medical or surgical treatment,

10 at the rates specified and in, or by, the institutions and 11 organizations named, of certain classes of persons whose 12 own resources, or the resources of whose responsible relatives as defined by section eighteen of chapter twenty-nine 14 of the revised statutes, are insufficient to pay for the same, 15 and for other purposes, namely:

For the care and support of children under sixteen years 2 of age including those supported away from their parents 3 under the provisions of sections fifty-one to fifty-five in-4 clusive, chapter sixty-four of the revised statutes, and acts 5 amendatory thereof, at not to exceed three dollars and fifty 6 cents per week, including direct payments from sources 7 other than the state:
