IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Department of the Attorney General.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Whenever the attorney general shall appoint any additional
2 assistant attorneys general as authorized under existing law,
3 or shall employ additional clerks as provided by statute, or
4 shall employ attorneys at law to collect claims due the state,
5 the compensation of such assistants, clerks or attorneys, as
6 approved by the governor and council, may be paid, if the
7 governor and council so direct, from moneys thus collected
8 by the attorney general's department.
