IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, to Pay the Unpaid Premiums Due on Account of Insurance on the State Pier and Sheds for Policies Issued in Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-three and Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-four.

Resolved: That there be paid in settlement of the unpaid 2 premiums due on account of insurance on the State Pier 3 at Portland for policies issued in nineteen hundred and 4 twenty-three and nineteen hundred and twenty-four the sum 5 of eleven thousand one hundred and one dollars and forty-6 six cents, together with interest on said policies from sixty 7 days after said policies were written to July first, nineteen 8 hundred and twenty-five, amounting to seven hundred and

9 sixty-one dollars and eleven cents, a total of eleven thou10 sand eight hundred and sixty-two dollars and fifty-seven
11 cents, of which ten thousand one hundred and eighty-two
12 dollars and fifty-seven cents be repaid by the directors of
13 the State Pier to the treasurer of state, said last named
14 amount to be repaid in such amounts and at such stated
15 periods as the directors of the port of Portland and the
16 governor and council may agree upon; provided, that the
17 amount so repaid shall all be returned to the state treasury
18 by July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-eight.
