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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

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AN ACT Relating to Itinerant Vendors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

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Section twenty-six of chapter forty-one of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter one hundred twenty-nine of the public laws of nineteen hundred and nineteen, is hereby further amended by striking out the words "or peddlers from vehicles," where they appear in the fifth line of the aforesaid amendment, so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 26. The provisions of the fifteen preceding sections shall not apply to sales made to dealers by commercial travelers or selling agents in the usual course of business, nor to bona fide sales of goods, wares and merchandise by sample for future delivery nor to hawkers or peddlers on

7 or of any other state or country whose laws impose no  
8 burden upon citizens of this state engaged in like business  
9 within their borders.'
