# STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, To Appropriate Money for the Maintenance of the Motor Vehicle Department of the Office of the Secretary of State.

*Resolved*: That there be and hereby is appropriated 2 the sum of one hundred thousand dollars for the year from 3 July I, 1927, to June 30, 1928, and the sum of one hundred 4 thousand dollars for the year from July I, 1928, to June 30, 5 1929, for expenses incurred by the secretary of state in 6 administering the motor vehicle department and registration 7 of motor vehicles, the licensing of operators thereof, and 8 purchase of registration plates.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The expense of maintaining the Motor Vehicle Department of the office of the Secretary of State is now derived from motor vehicle fees. This resolve is to provide that hereafter this department shall be maintained by state appropriation the same as other departments of the state government. The effect of so doing will be to make more money available for highway maintenance purposes and to assist in financing any further bond issues which may be authorized.
