STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, To Appropriate Money for the Maintenance of the State Highway Department.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of one hundred thousand dollars for the year from 3 July I, 1927, to June 30, 1928, and the sum of one hundred 4 thousand dollars for the year from July I, 1928, to June 5 30, 1929, for salary of the state highway commission, and 6 for all other salaries, clerk hire and joint office expenses, 7 and expenses incurred in maintaining the state highway de-8 partment and direction and control of highway and bridge 9 work as provided by statute.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The expense of maintaining the State Highway Commission is now derived from motor vehicle fees. This resolve is to provide that hereafter this department shall be maintained by state appropriation the same as other departments of the state government. The effect of so doing will be to make more money available for highway maintenance purposes and to assist in financing any further bond issues which may be authorized.
