STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, To Appropriate Money for the Maintenance of State Highway Police.

*Resolved*: That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars for the 3 year from July 1, 1927, to June 30, 1928, and the sum of 4 one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars for the year from 5 July 1, 1928, to June 30, 1929, for salary, compensation and 6 clerk hire of the state highway police and for expenses in-7 curred in the performance of their official duties.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

The expense of maintaining the State Highway Police is now derived from motor vehicle fees. This resolve is to provide that hereafter this department shall be maintained by state appropriation the same as other departments of the state government. The effect of so doing will be to make more money available for highway maintenance purposes and to assist in financing any further bond issues which may be authorized.
