STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT, to Authorize the Town of Boothbay Harbor to Raise Money for the Purpose of Helping Keep in Repair the Old Cemetery in the Town of Boothbay.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: The inhabitants of the town of Boothbay Harbor, a mu-2 nicipal corporation in the county of Lincoln and State of
Maine, are hereby authorized to raise money, to help keep
4 in good repair and condition all monuments, headstones,
5 markers and graves in the old burying ground situated in
6 the town of Boothbay, it being a cemetery where the early
7 settlers of Boothbay and Boothbay Harbor were buried and
8 also to keep all bushes and grass cut and the trees and shrubs
9 properly trimmed. The sums so raised may be expended 10 by the town of Boothbay Harbor or its servants or agents 11 or by a committee consisting of citizens of Boothbay, Booth-12 bay Harbor and any church organization or society inter-13 ested in keeping such burying ground in proper condition 14 and repair.
