STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT, Relating to Salary and Expenses of the County
Commissioners of Lincoln County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section forty-two of chapter one hundred and seventeen
2 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter one hundred
3 and seventy-three of the public laws of nineteen hundred
4 and seventeen, as amended by chapters two hundred and
5 fourteen and two hundred and forty-one of the public laws
6 of nineteen hundred and nineteen, as amended by chapter
7 two hundred and nineteen of the public laws of nineteen
8 hundred and twenty-one, as amended by chapter one hun-
9 dred and three of the public laws of nineteen hundred and
10 twenty-three, and as amended by chapter thirty-nine of the

11 public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-five, is hereby
12 further amended by striking out the words "three hundred
13 and fifty" in the twelfth line of said section and inserting in
14 place thereof the words 'five hundred,' so that the twelfth
15 line of said section shall read as follows:

'Lincoln, five hundred dollars.'

To the Committee on Fees and Salaries of the 83rd Legislature:

The undersigned, officers of the County, believing that the board of County Commissioners are justly entitled to an increase in their salary, respectfully ask that you give favorable consideration to the bill now before you for such increase.
