## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

---

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Clerk of Courts in  
Lincoln County.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section forty of chapter one hundred and seventeen of  
2 the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended  
3 by striking out the words "twelve hundred" in the thirteenth  
4 line thereof, and inserting in place thereof, the words 'two  
5 thousand,' so that said section, as amended, shall read as  
6 follows:

'Sect. 40. The clerks of the judicial courts in the several  
2 counties shall receive annual salaries from the treasuries of  
3 the counties in monthly payments, paid on the last day of

4 each month as follows :

'Androscoggin, twenty-two hundred dollars.

'Aroostook, two thousand dollars.

'Cumberland, twenty-eight hundred dollars, deputy clerk  
of courts, two thousand dollars.

'Franklin, fifteen hundred dollars.

'Hancock, twenty-one hundred dollars.

'Kennebec, twenty-five hundred dollars.

'Knox, eighteen hundred dollars.

'Lincoln, two thousand dollars.

'Oxford, eighteen hundred dollars.

'Penobscot, twenty-five hundred dollars.

'Piscataquis, fourteen hundred dollars.

'Sagadahoc, twenty-one hundred dollars.

'Somerset, twenty-five hundred dollars.

'Waldo, twelve hundred dollars.

'Washington, sixteen hundred dollars.

'York, twenty-five hundred dollars.

'The sums above mentioned shall be in full compensation  
2 for the performance of all duties required of clerks, includ-  
3 ing those performed by them as clerks of the supreme  
4 judicial court, superior and county commissioners' courts,  
5 or by clerks pro tempore employed by them, and the sum  
6 provided for the clerk in Lincoln County shall be in full for  
7 all such services and also in full for services as clerk of  
8 Lincoln municipal court, except as provided in section  
9 forty-five of chapter eighty-two of the revised statutes.

10 They shall account quarterly under oath to the county  
11 treasurer for all fees received by them or payable to them  
12 by virtue of the office, except fees collected by them in  
13 naturalization proceedings under the act of congress of  
14 June twenty-ninth, nineteen hundred and six, as amended  
15 by the act of congress of June twenty-fifth, nineteen hundred  
16 and ten, specifying the items, and shall pay the whole  
17 amount of the same to the treasurers of their respective  
18 counties quarterly, on the first days of January, April, July  
19 and October of each year.'
