STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relative to the Practice of Chiropractic by Veterans of the Spanish-American War.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Any person who is a veteran of the Spanish-American war, 2 with an honorable discharge from the United States gov-3 ernment, and who at the time of entering said service was 4 a resident of the state of Maine, and who has pursued a 5 course of study of not less than eighteen months in an 6 incorporated school or college teaching chiropractice and 7 graduated therefrom, may in the discretion of said board

8 be granted a license to practice chiropractic in this state.
