STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Insurance Commissioner.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S. c. 118, sec. 17, relating to licenses of insurance agents. 2 Section seventeen of chapter one hundred and eighteen of 3 the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out the 4 words "two dollars" in the nineteenth line and inserting in 5 place thereof the words 'twenty-five dollars,' and by striking 6 out the words "two dollars" in the twenty-first line and in-7 serting in place thereof the words 'twenty-five dollars,' so 8 that the sixth and seventh paragraphs of said section as 9 amended shall read as follows:

'For each license issued to an agent of any insurance com-2 pany except a domestic mutual fire insurance company, or

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3 to an agent of any fraternal beneficiary association, foreign
4 surety company, credit insurance, or title insurance com5 pany, and each renewal thereof, twenty-five dollars.

For each license issued to a firm or corporation to act as 2 insurance agents, and each renewal thereof, twenty-five dol-3 lars for each person named in the license.'
