IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Salaries of Registers of Probate.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section thirty-nine of chapter one hundred and seventeen
2 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter one hundred
3 and sixty-seven, of the public laws of nineteen hundred and
4 seventeen, chapter two hundred and fourteen of the public
5 laws of nineteen hundred and nineteen and chapter two
6 hundred and nineteen of the public laws of nineteen hun7 dred and twenty-one, as amended by chapter fifty-six of the
8 public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-three, is hereby
9 further amended by striking out the words, "nine hundred

11 thereof the words 'twelve hundred dollars,' so that said 12 section, as amended, shall read as follows: 'Sect. 39. Increase in Lincoln County: Registers of Pro-2 bate in the several Counties shall receive annual salaries 3 from the treasuries of the counties in monthly payments, 4 paid on the last of each month, as follows: 'Androscoggin, sixteen hundred dollars, 'Aroostook, fifteen hundred dollars, 'Cumberland, two thousand dollars, 'Franklin, nine hundred dollars, 'Hancock, one thousand dollars, 'Kennebec, eighteen hundred dollars, 'Knox, twelve hundred fifty dollars, 'Lincoln, twelve hundred dollars, 'Oxford, fifteen hundred dollars, 'Penobscot, eighteen hundred dollars, 'Piscataguis, twelve hundred dollars, 'Sagadahoc, one thousand dollars, 'Somerset, fifteen hundred dollars, 'Waldo, twelve hundred dollars, 'Washington, one thousand dollars, 'York, fifteen hundred dollars. 'The sums above mentioned shall be in full compensation
