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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

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AN ACT to Amend Section Twenty-one of Chapter Seven of the Revised Statutes, in Relation to Closing of Polls at Elections.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section twenty-one of chapter seven of the revised statutes, 2 as amended by chapter ten of the public laws of nineteen 3 hundred nineteen, is hereby further amended by striking out 4 in the fifth line thereof the word "six" and inserting in place 5 thereof the word 'seven,' so that said section, as amended, 6 shall read as follows:

'Meetings for the election of state and county officers, and 2 for the election of municipal officers in cities, may be opened 3 at six o'clock in the forenoon, and shall be opened not later

4 than ten o'clock in the forenoon; the polls shall be kept open  
5 until seven o'clock in the afternoon and shall then be closed.  
6 Notice of the time of opening and closing shall be given in  
7 the warrant calling the meeting.'
