STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Amend Section Twenty-one of Chapter Seven of the Revised Statutes, in Relation to Closing of Polls at Elections.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section twenty-one of chapter seven of the revised statutes, *a* as amended by chapter ten of the public laws of nineteen
hundred nineteen, is hereby further amended by striking out
in the fifth line thereof the word "six" and inserting in place
thereof the word 'seven,' so that said section, as amended,
shall read as follows:

'Meetings for the election of state and county officers, and 2 for the election of municipal officers in cities, may be opened 3 at six o'clock in the forenoon, and shall be opened not later

4 than ten o'clock in the forenoon; the polls shall be kept open
5 until seven o'clock in the afternoon and shall then be closed.
6 Notice of the time of opening and closing shall be given in
7 the warrant calling the meeting.'
