STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Construction of a Raised Road across the Bar between Deer Isle and Little Deer Isle, in the Town of Deer Isle, in the County of Hancock.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Authority is hereby given to lay out, construct and maintain a raised road, subject to the approval of the United States War Department, across the bar between the islands of Deer Isle and Little Deer Isle, in the county of Hancock.

Sect. 2. That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of fifteen thousand dollars for the laying out and construction of a raised road across the bar between the islands

4 of Deer Isle and Little Deer Isle, in said county of Hancock;
5 said sum to be expended under the direction of the State
6 Highway Department.
