STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Provide for Compensation of Justices of the
Superior Courts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The justices of the superior courts shall each
2 receive an annual salary of seventy-five hundred dollars, to-
3 gether with actual expenses as now provided by law.

Sect. 2. Chapter one hundred seventeen, section six of
2 the revised statutes, chapter two hundred sixty, section
3 nine of the public laws of nineteen hundred seventeen, chap-
4 ter nine, section nine, of the public laws of nineteen hun-
5 dred nineteen, and chapter one hundred ninety-two, section

6 one of the public laws of nineteen hundred twenty-one, are
7 each amended in accordance with this chapter.

Sect. 3. The provisions of this act shall relate back to
2 January first, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, so that
3 the increase of salaries herein provided shall take effect as
4 of that date.
