HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relative to Sunday Hunting.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section seventy-three of chapter two hundred nineteen of
2 the public laws of nineteen hundred seventeen, declaring
3 Sunday to be a closed season on wild animals and wild
4 birds, is hereby repealed.
