STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Abolish the Superior Court of the County of
Penobscot.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter nine of the public laws of nineteen
2 hundred and nineteen, being an act to establish a superior
3 court in the county of Penobscot, is hereby repealed.

Sect. 2. All actions civil or criminal pending on the docket
2 of said superior court for said county of Penobscot shall
3 be transferred to the docket of the supreme judicial court
4 for said county of Penobscot to be there disposed of ac-
5 cording to law.

Sect. 3. Five terms of the supreme judicial court shall

2 hereafter be held at Bangor in said county of Penobscot
3 for the trial of civil actions, of persons accused of offenses
4 and for the transaction of all other business as follows: On
5 the first Tuesdays of January, April and October in each
6 year for the transaction of civil business, and on the first
7 Tuesdays of February and September of each year for the
8 transaction of criminal business.
