STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Confer the Power to Issue Subpoenas to the City Council and Civil Service Commission of the City of Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section I. The city council and civil service commission
2 of the city of Portland shall have power to issue subpoenas,
3 compel the attendance of witnesses and the production of
4 books, accounts, papers, documents and testimony at any
5 meeting of said city council and civil service commission at
6 which a hearing is had in any matter of inquiry regarding
7 any alleged dereliction of duty of any city officer or any
8 person in the employ of the city, or in any hearing on any
9 municipal matters.

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Sect. 2. Any person failing to comply with the subpoena 2 issued, as above provided, shall be punished by a fine of 3 not less than ten dollars or more than one hundred dollars 4 or by imprisonment not more than thirty days.
