STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Provide for the Retirement of Firemen, in the City of Augusta, Upon Half Pay.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The city of Augusta is hereby authorized to

- 2 provide for the retirement of all permanent members of its
- 3 fire department, who have served in said fire department,
- 4 for a term of at least twenty years, and who may have
- 5 been honorably discharged from either of said municipal
- 6 departments of said city of Augusta, by reason of having
- 7 attained the age of sixty-five years or by reason of perma-
- 8 nent injuries or permanent physical incapacity, which is the
- 9 result of an incident of service in said fire department, 10 upon a pension of half pay.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect and be in full force, 2 when approved by a majority vote of the inhabitants of 3 said city, qualified to vote in municipal affairs, at the next 4 legal annual meeting, held after the first day of December, 5 in the year nineteen hundred twenty-eight. For the pur-6 poses of said meeting, the city clerk shall reduce the sub-7 ject matter of this act to the following question: "Shall the 8 act relating to the retirement of police officers and firemen, 9 upon half pay, be accepted" and the voters shall indicate 10 by a cross, placed within a square upon their ballots, over 11 the words "Yes" or "No" their opinion of the same.
