STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Exemption of Certain Property from
Taxation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., CHAP. 10, SEC. 6, PAR. XIII; RELATING TO
2 EXEMPTION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY FROM
3 TAXATION, AMENDED. Paragraph XIII of section six
4 of chapter ten of the revised statutes is hereby amended by
5 striking out the whole of said section and inserting in place
6 thereof the following:

'XIII. All bonds, notes, and other evidence of indebted-
2 ness secured by mortgage on property situated in this state.'
