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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

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AN ACT to Set Off a Part of the Town of Sebec and Annex  
the Same to the Town of Bowerbank.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. All that part of the town of Sebec, in the  
2 county of Piscataquis, in the northwesterly corner thereof,  
3 which lies north of Sebec Lake and westerly of Bear Brook,  
4 so-called, is hereby set off from said town of Sebec and  
5 annexed to the town of Bowerbank in said county of  
6 Piscataquis.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect March thirty-first, nine-  
2 teen hundred twenty-eight, unless either or both of said  
3 towns of Bowerbank and Sebec shall, at an annual meeting  
4 of the legal voters, or at a special meeting of the legal

5 voters thereof called for that purpose and acting under an  
6 appropriate article in the warrant for such meeting, vote  
7 against such division.
