STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Create the Office of Deputy Treasurer of Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section I. The treasurer of Cumberland county may ap-2 point a deputy treasurer who shall assist the treasurer in 3 performing the duties of his office. Such deputy treasurer 4 shall give bond to the county for the faithful discharge of 5 his duties in such sum as the county commissioners order 6 and with such sureties as they approve in writing thereon, 7 the premium of such bond to be met by the county. The 8 salary of such deputy treasurer shall be fifteen hundred dol-9 lars per annum, payable in monthly installments, paid on 10 the last day of each month.

Sect. 2. Section forty-five of chapter two hundred nine-2 teen of the public laws of nineteen hundred twenty-one is 3 hereby amended by striking out at the end of the fourth 4 paragraph thereof the words "for clerks in the office of 5 county treasurer, seven hundred and twenty dollars," so that 6 the same shall read:

'For clerks in the office of register of deeds, thirty-eight 2 hundred and fifty-two dollars; deputy register of deeds, elev-3 en hundred and forty-four dollars; for clerks in the office 4 of register of probate, thirty-two hundred and seventy-two 5 dollars; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, forty-6 three hundred and twenty-four dollars; for clerks in the 7 office of recorder of the Portland municipal court, sixteen 8 hundred and twelve dollars; for clerks in the office of coun-9 ty attorney, seven hundred and forty-two dollars; for clerks 10 in the office of sheriff, seven hundred twenty-eight dollars.'
