STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, to Appropriate Money for the Erection of a New
State Library.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of five hundred thousand dollars for the erection of a
3 suitable building for the Maine State Library.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

It is suggested that in lieu of any formal statement of facts the members of the legislature inspect the quarters of the existing state library on the second floor of the state building. These speak for themselves. The library is an excellent library. Its usefulness is being limited from day to day by the congested condition now existing, for which there seems to be no relief except through obtaining new quarters.
