STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Exemptions from Taxation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Paragraph one of section six of chapter ten of the revised
2 statutes is hereby amended so that, as amended, it shall
3 read as follows:

‘1. The property of the United States and of this state,
2 and the property of any public municipal corporation of
3 this state, appropriated to public uses, if located within the
4 territory constituting such public municipal corporation; but
5 all such property of any public municipal corporation located
6 outside of the territory constituting said corporation and not
7 employed in serving the municipal uses of any city or town
8 which is, in whole or in part, within such outside territory,

9 shall be taxed as is other property. Nothing herein con-
10 tained shall abridge any power of taxation possessed by any
11 city or town by virtue of any special act, or exempt from
12 taxation such property or any part thereof which is not
13 used by any city or town wherein said property is located,
14 both for the municipal purposes of such city or town and
15 for domestic purposes therein.'
