IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relative to Automobile Plates.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Paragraph two, of section forty-eight of public laws of
2 nineteen hundred twenty-one, is hereby amended by insert-
3 ing after the word "issued" in the second line thereof, the
4 following: 'except that on and after December twenty-fifth
5 of such calendar year, it shall be lawful to use and display
6 on motor vehicles, the number plates issued for the next
7 succeeding year,' so that said paragraph as amended shall
8 read as follows:

'Number plates so furnished shall be valid only for the
2 calendar year for which they are issued, except that on
3 and after December twenty-fifth of such calendar year, it

4 shall be lawful to use and display on motor vehicles, the
5 number plates issued for the next succeeding year. Each
6 number plate displayed shall be horizontal and shall be
7 so fastened as not to swing, and its lower edges shall be at
8 least twelve inches from the ground. Not more than one
9 set of number plates shall be displayed upon any vehicle,
10 except as may be otherwise permitted by this act.'
