STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Two or More Towns Maintaining Union Town Farm.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section fifteen of chapter twenty-nine of the revised stat-2 utes is hereby amended by striking out the whole of said 3 section and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Towns, or two or more towns, in the same county, by 2 vote thereof, at an annual, or special town meeting called 3 for that purpose by an appropriate article in the warrant, 4 may acquire by purchase, lease or otherwise, land and build-5 ings together with household furniture, farming tools, im-6 plements and equipment and live stock, for the purpose of 7 suitably, efficiently and humanely caring for the poor and 8 infirm within their respective territorial limits, such lands 9 to be within one of such towns, upon such terms, not in-10 consistent with the laws of the state, as may be agreed upon 11 by vote of the towns, or by contract of the municipal offi-12 cers thereof after the votes of the towns have authorized 13 such purchase or maintenance. Existing homes used for 14 such dependents may be used as homes for dependents in 15 towns making such union when they so agree.'
