STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Regulate Fishing in Twin Brooks, So-called, Tributary to Aziscohos Lake, County of Oxford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to fish for,
2 take, catch or kill, any kind of fish at any time in either of
3 the brooks known as Twin Brooks, so-called, tributaries to
4 Aziscohos Lake, in the county of Oxford.

Sect. 2. It shall also be unlawful for any person to have 2 in possession at any time any kind of fish taken in either of 3 said brooks.

Sect. 3. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall 2 be subject to a penalty of not less than ten dollars, nor more 3 than thirty dollars and costs for each offense, and a further 4 penalty of one dollar for each fish taken, caught, killed, or 5 had in possession in violation of any provision of this act.

Sect. 4. In all prosecutions arising under this act, trial 2 justices, police and municipal courts within their counties 3 shall have original and concurrent jurisdiction with the su-4 preme judicial court and superior courts.
