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S T A T E   O F   M A I N E

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

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RESOLVE, Authorizing the Governor to Receive from the  
Secretary of War of the United States Such "Other Funds"  
Remaining to the Credit of the National Guard of This State  
and to Distribute Them for the Benefit of Said National  
Guard.

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Whereas, it has been duly made known to the proper au-  
thorities of this state that the secretary of war of the United  
states has in his possession, as trustee, certain moneys known  
as "Other Funds," which had been collected for their own use  
and benefit by certain National Guard organizations that were  
broken up as units for or as the result of service in the World  
war, and have not been reconstituted; and

Whereas, it further appears that the secretary of war, as  
trustee, desires to turn over to a substitute trustee, duly author-

ized by this state, such portion of the said funds as equitably belongs to the National Guard of this state, now therefore be it

Resolved: By the House of Representatives, the Senate  
2 concurring, that the governor is hereby authorized to re-  
3 ceive such funds as trustee, and to distribute them for the  
4 benefit of the National Guard of this state, in such manner  
5 as his judgment shall dictate.
