## STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Prohibit Fishing in Lily Pond, in the Town of Rockport, County of Knox.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section I. It shall be unlawful for any person at any
2 time to fish for, take, catch or kill any kind of fish in Lily
3 Pond, so-called, in the town of Rockport, county of Knox,
4 for a period of two years from September thirtieth, nine5 teen hundred and twenty-seven. It shall also be unlawful
6 for any person to have in possession at any time any kind
7 of fish taken in violation of any provision of this act.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall 2 be subject to a penalty of not less than ten dollars, nor more 3 than thirty dollars and costs for each offense, and a further

4 penalty of one dollar for each fish taken, caught, killed or
5 had in possession in violation of any provision of this act.
Sect. 3. In all prosecutions arising under this act, trial
2 justices, police and municipal courts within their counties
3 shall have original and concurrent jurisdiction with the su4 preme judicial court and superior courts.
