Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section two of chapter forty-six of the private and special
2 laws of eighteen hundred eighty-seven is hereby amended
3 by striking out the words "not exceeding eighty thousand
4 dollars," in the third line thereof, so that said section, as
5 amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 2. Said corporation, for said purposes, may hold
2 real and personal estates necessary and convenient thereof.'
