STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Digging Out of Fox Dens.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section forty-seven of chapter thirty-three of the revised

2 statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred nineteen of

3 the public laws of nineteen hundred seventeen, as amended

4 by chapter one hundred ninety-six of the public laws of

5 nineteen hundred nineteen, is hereby further amended by

6 striking out in the second line thereof the words "during

7 closed season on foxes," and by striking out in the sixth

8 line thereof the word "ten" and inserting in lieu thereof

9 the words 'twenty-five,' so that said section, as amended,

'No person shall at any time dig out, molest, or destroy, 2 in any way, any fox den or fox dens, or remove or cause 3 to be removed therefrom any fox or foxes, except those 4 enclosed in private fox ranches. Whoever violates any 5 provision of this section shall pay a fine of twenty-five dol-6 lars and costs for each offense.'
