STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Protection of Beaver.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section forty-five of chapter thirty-three of the revised
2 statutes as amended by section fourteen of chapter one hun3 dred ninety-six of the laws of nineteen hundred nineteen
4 is hereby amended by striking out all of said section and
5 by substituting therefor the following section:

'Sect. 45. The commissioner of inland fisheries and game, 2 upon written complaint of any water company required to 3 furnish pure water to its customers, that beaver are pol-4 luting its water supply, shall have authority to declare an 5 open season for beaver on such sections of land and waters 6 as is necessary to remove the beaver that are polluting said

7 waters; or upon written complaint of any land owner that 8 beaver are doing actual, substantial damage to his property, 9 shall have authority to declare an open season for beaver to upon such land for such period of time and under such II conditions as he may deem necessary to remove the beaver 12 that are doing the damage complained of, during which open 13 season it shall be lawful for any person holding a beaver 14 trapping license issued in accordance with the provisions 15 of section fifty of this chapter to trap beaver thereon with-16 out securing permission of the land owner. No open sea-17 son for beaver as contemplated by this section shall take 18 effect until the commissioner of inland fisheries and game 19 shall have caused notice of such proposed open season to 20 be published once in a newspaper printed in the county in 21 which the land on which the open season for beaver is de-22 clared is located, and said commissioner shall also file copy 23 of said notice of open season with the clerk of the town or 24 plantation in which such land is located, or, if the land is 25 in an unorganized place, with the clerk of courts for the 26 county in which the land is located. Whenever during a 27 special open season on beaver as is contemplated by this sec-28 tion it shall appear to the commissioner of inland fisheries 29 and game that the privileges of such open season are being 30 abused in any place, said commissioner of inland fisheries 31 and game may suspend the open season and declare it close 32 season for beaver on such land for such time as he may 33 designate. No person shall take any beaver anywhere in

34 the state at any time except during such open season as 35 may be declared by the commissioner of inland fisheries 36 and game in accordance with the provisions of this section. 37 Whoever takes any beaver in violation of any provision 38 of this section shall be punished by a fine of one hundred 30 dollars and costs for each beaver taken, caught, or killed 40 in violation of any provision of this section. It shall also 41 be unlawful, under the same penalty, for any person to 42 have in possession at any time any beaver, or part thereof, 43 taken in violation of any provision of this section. It shall 44 also be unlawful, under the same penalty, for any person, 45 firm or corporation, to sell, give away, buy, accept as a gift, 46 offer for transportation or transport any beaver skin or 47 beaver skins unless each skin is marked with an official seal 48 by the commissioner of inland fisheries and game or by an 49 agent duly appointed by said commissioner to mark such 50 skins.'
