IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Limiting the Granting of Hunting Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The third paragraph of section three of chapter one hundred and seventy-three of the public laws of nineteen hundred and nineteen, as amended by chapter one hundred and twenty-one of the public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-three, is hereby further amended by striking out all of said paragraph and by substituting therefor the following paragraph:

'No such certificate shall be granted to any person under fifteen years of age, but any resident under fifteen years of age may fish in waters open to fishing, without such certificate.'
