STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Prohibiting Use of Names of Sheriffs, Deputy Sheriffs and Police Officers for Gift Contests.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

No person shall use the name of any sheriff, deputy sheriff, 2 or police officer at any fair, festival, or exhibition, for the 3 purpose of selling tickets, setting up or promoting any raffle 4 or gift enterprise, or having a present voted to him, or voted 5 for him in his name. Any person who violates the provi-6 sions of this act shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor 7 and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by fine of 8 not less than five, nor more than twenty dollars for each 9 offense, to be enforced on complaint.
