STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT for the Better Protection of Shell Fish in the Town
of Georgetown.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. That section one, chapter seventy, laws of
2 Maine for the year nineteen hundred and three, be amended
3 as follows: by striking out the words "any person tempo-
4 rarily resident therein or the riparian owner of such flats,
5 may take therefrom for the immediate use of himself or his
6 family, not exceeding one bushel at any tide," and substi-
7 tuting therefor the following: 'any person temporarily resi-
8 dent therein or the riparian owner of such flats, may take
9 therefrom for the immediate use of himself of his family,
10 not exceeding one-half bushel at any tide, and the aggregate
11 amount to be taken by members of the same immediate fam-
12 ily, shall not exceed one-half bushel at any tide.'
