## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Establish Duck Sanctuaries in Knox County.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. For a period of four years from the first day  
2 of August, nineteen hundred twenty-seven, it shall be un-  
3 lawful for any person to hunt, pursue, shoot at or kill, any  
4 wild bird or wild animal at any time on Grassy pond, or  
5 from the shores of said pond, which pond is situated in the  
6 towns of Rockport and Hope, in the county of Knox.

Sect. 2. For a period of four years from August first,  
2 nineteen hundred twenty-seven, it shall also be unlawful  
3 for any person to hunt, pursue, shoot at or kill, any wild  
4 bird or wild animal at any time in Glencove, so called, in  
5 Penobscot bay, which cove is situated in the town of Rock-

6 port, in the county of Knox, and which cove is bounded  
7 as follows, to wit: on the north, west and south by the main  
8 land, on the east by a line extending from Smith's Point  
9 to Ram island and from Ram island to the easterly point of  
10 Pine Hill in said Rockport.

Sect. 3. It shall also be unlawful for any person to have  
2 in possession at any time, any wild bird or wild animal  
3 taken in violation of any provision of this act.

Sect. 4. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall  
2 be subject to a penalty of not less than five dollars nor  
3 more than fifty dollars and costs for each offense or im-  
4 prisonment for thirty days or both said fine and imprison-  
5 ment.

Sect. 5. In all prosecutions arising under this act, trial  
2 justices, police and municipal courts, within their respective  
3 counties, shall have, upon complaint, original and concur-  
4 rent jurisdiction with the supreme judicial court and su-  
5 perior courts.
