IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of Joseph L. Paquin, to Cover Salary as
Secretary of the Board of Prison Commissioners for the
Years July First, Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-five, to June
Thirtieth, Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-seven, at Three
Hundred Dollars Per Year, as Per Section One, Chapter
One Hundred and Ninety-five, Laws of Nineteen Hundred
and Seventeen.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the
2 sum of six hundred dollars to be paid Joseph L. Paquin,
3 of Thomaston, Maine, in full payment, satisfaction and dis-
4 charge, of his salary as secretary of the board of prison

5 commissioners, for the years July first, nineteen hundred
6 and twenty-five, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and
7 twenty-seven, inclusive, no appropriation having been made
8 to cover the said salary for said years.
