## STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Passes on Common Carriers for Public Utilities Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section fifty-one of chapter fifty-six of the revised statutes
2 is hereby amended by striking out all of the section after
3 the word "duties" in the third line thereof. That said sec4 tion, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Every public utility within the state shall furnish all rea-2 sonable facilities to the public utilities commission for the 3 prompt and faithful discharge of its duties.'
