### STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Robert W. Traip Academy.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section I. The trustees under the will of Robert W.
2 Traip, late of Kittery, and their successors in trust, for the 3 benefit of Robert W. Traip Academy, are authorized to 4 receive gifts, bequests and devises of real or personal prop-5 erty to be administered according to the terms of the instru-6 ment creating the gift, devise or bequest.

Sect. 2. The acceptance of any gift, devise or bequest 2 by said trustees, and all other acts of said trustees, and all 3 gifts, bequests and devises made to said trustees are hereby 4 ratified, confirmed and made valid.
