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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

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AN ACT to Incorporate Augusta Humane Society.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Mabel Connor, Frank E. Mace, Rena M. Foss,  
2 Perley H. Sawyer and Robert B. Williamson, all of Au-  
3 gusta in the county of Kennebec and state of Maine, their  
4 associates and successors, are hereby created a body politic  
5 and corporate by the name of Augusta Humane Society to  
6 be located at said Augusta, to urge the proper treatment of  
7 animals, to assist in the prevention of cruelty and to en-  
8 courage the training of all persons, and more especially of  
9 children, that they may better understand the value and  
10 worth of our dumb and helpless friends, with all the powers  
11 and privileges, and subject to all the duties, liabilities and

12 restrictions, provided and set forth in all general laws which  
13 now are, or hereafter may be, in force relating to such cor-  
14 porations; with authority to hold real and personal estate  
15 for the purposes of the corporation not exceeding in amount  
16 one hundred thousand dollars.

Sect. 2. Either of the first two named corporators are au-  
2 thorized to call the first meeting of said society by mailing  
3 to each corporator a written or printed notice, setting forth  
4 the time and place of holding said meeting, at least seven  
5 days before the time appointed for holding such meeting.
