STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relative to Use of Power Boats.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section fifty-eight of chapter two hundred and nineteen

- 2 of the public laws of one thousand nine hundred and seven-
- 3 teen, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following
- 4 words: 'This section shall not apply to tide waters lying
- 5 between Sheepscot Bay and Cape Elizabeth Light,' so that
- 6 said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 58. No person shall at any time use a boat or launch

- 2 of any kind propelled by steam, naptha, gasoline or electri-
- 3 city, or any other mode than the ordinary sailboat or row-
- 4 boat, in chasing, hunting or gunning any sea birds, duck or
- 5 water fowl in any inland or tidal waters of this state, under

6 a penalty of not less than twenty-five, nor more than one 7 hundred dollars and costs for each offense. This section 8 shall not apply to tide waters lying between Sheepscot Bay

9 and Cape Elizabeth Light.'
