A N A C T f o r t h e P r o t e c t i o n o f D e e r i n C u m b e r l a n d C o u n t y .

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. There shall be an annual closed season on
2 deer in the county of Cumberland from the first day of
3 December of each year until the fifteenth day of November
4 of the following year, both days inclusive, during which
5 closed season it shall be unlawful for any person to hunt,
6 chase, catch or kill any deer in said county.

It shall also be unlawful for any person to have in posses-
2 sion at any time any deer taken in violation of any provision
3 of this act.

Whoever violates any provision of this act shall pay a fine

2 of not less than fifty dollars nor more than one hundred
3 dollars and costs for each offense.

Sect. 2. So much of section thirty-eight, chapter two hun-
2 dred and nineteen of the public laws of nineteen hundred
3 and seventeen, as amended, as is inconsistent with the pro-
4 visions of this act, is hereby repealed.
