## STATE OF MAINE

---

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

---

AN ACT to Create a Fish and Game Sanctuary within the  
Limits of Property of the Dover-Foxcroft Water District,  
in the Town of Guilford, County of Piscataquis.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to fish for,  
2 take, catch or kill any kind of fish at any time in Salmon  
3 Pond, so-called, which pond is situated in the town of  
4 Guilford, in the county of Piscataquis, said pond being the  
5 source of water supply for the Dover-Foxcroft Water Dis-  
6 trict. It shall also be unlawful for any person to have in  
7 possession at any time any kind of fish taken in said Salmon  
8 Pond.

Sect. 2. It shall also be unlawful for any person to hunt,

2 chase, catch, kill, or destroy any wild bird or wild animal  
3 at any time within a distance of one quarter of a mile of  
4 said Salmon Pond, in the town of Guilford, in the county  
5 of Piscataquis. It shall also be unlawful for any person to  
6 have in possession at any time any wild bird or wild animal  
7 or part or parts thereof taken within the above described  
8 territory.

Sect. 3. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall  
2 be subject to a penalty of not less than \$10 nor more than  
3 \$300 and costs for each offense, or imprisonment for sixty  
4 days, or both said fine and imprisonment.

Sect. 4. In all prosecutions arising under this act, trial  
2 justices, police and municipal courts within their counties  
3 shall have, upon complaint, original and concurrent juris-  
4 diction with the supreme judicial court and superior courts.
