STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to a Mill Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

In addition to any other taxes, a tax of one mill on a dol-
2 lar shall be assessed annually upon all property of the state
3 according to the value thereof, and shall be known as the
4 Mill Tax State Highway Fund.

This fund shall be used for the construction and recon-
2 struction, exclusively, of state highways, as they are defined
3 in section five of chapter twenty-five of the revised stat-
4 utes and shall be divided equitably among the several coun-
5 ties of the state.
