STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Exemption of Taxation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Paragraph four of section six of chapter ten of the revised
2 statutes is hereby amended by striking out in the first line
3 thereof the word "two" and inserting in lieu thereof the
4 word 'eight,' so that said paragraph, as amended, shall read
5 as follows:

'IV. The household furniture of each person, not exceed-
2 ing eight hundred dollars to any one family, his wearing
3 apparel, farming utensils, mechanic's tools necessary for his
4 business, and musical instruments not exceeding in value
5 fifty dollars to one family.'
